Ecclesiastes 3:1-13 NIV

- Two words here used for season and time
 - Word translated seasons is the Greek kairos
 - Septuagint= Greek translation of OT
 - Qualitative, moments, not actual watch time
 - Kris Vallotton= Divine Favor meets Divine Opportunity
 - Word translated ‘time’ is the Greek Chronos
 - Actual clock time
 - Where all the ‘stuff’ happens, could be bad could be good
 - This is the ‘time’ that my wife has no concept of
 - 2018 Star Word
- Jesus
 - Had a lot to say about ‘time’, but never mentioned actual chronos (Years, months, days, hours, minutes, seconds)
 - Wasn’t really concerned with it
 - Uganda Time
 - Did talk a lot about seasons, generations, signs of the time, etc.
 - Kairos
 - Lives outside of time
 - Eternity is not concerned with time
 - Yes Jesus was born as a man and lived on earth in a specific time
- Us
 - The world is obsessed with Chronos= Trendy, In, Relevant
 - I hate reading church leadership material
 - V. 11 “eternity in their heart’
 - Born into a season=kairos, at a time= chronos, FOR A REASON
 - It’s a divine appointment
 - Inside this kairos or season there are inevitable ‘Chronos’ things that are gonna happen, listed here in Ecclesiastes
 - Born/die, plant/harvest, weep/laugh, mourn/dance, Gain/lose (weight, 😊), silence/speak, war/peace
 - Jesus= Set our heart on things above
 - Get through the Chronos, so we can enjoy the kairos
